



Longridge Band – 100 Club Rules

1. The 100 Club will operate as a Small Lottery as defined by the Gambling Act 2005.
2. The sole object of the Club is to raise funds for Longridge Band.
3. 'The Club' shall be administered by a Committee consisting of three Band Trustees who shall be appointed by the Trustees of the Band. The Club Committee shall elect from their number one member as Treasurer who shall be responsible for keeping the accounts of 'The Longridge Band 100 Club'.
4. Anybody over 16 years can become a member of the 100 Club. Band Trustees, Patrons and Members are encouraged to join the Club and to offer membership to relatives and friends. The 100 Club shall **not** be limited to 100 members. The more shares/numbers we sell, the bigger the prizes!
5. Applications for Membership must be on the official application form (attached).
6. An up to date list of 100 Club members will be maintained on the Longridge Band website.
7. The subscription to the 100 Club for one number/share shall be £30 per annum payable in advance by on-line transfer, standing order. This will give members one number which will be placed in 4 draws (i.e. cost is £7.50 per quarter). This number shall remain the member's provided their subscription is up to date. Members may have and are encouraged to have multiple subscriptions.
8. The Club will be run on an annual basis commencing on 1st July 2018. There is no provision to opt in/out on a quarterly basis. Admission to the draw will commence in the quarter following receipt of the subscription provided transfers are cleared through the member's Bank. This year's annual deadline for payment is midnight 30th June. Members joining after the start of the normal 100 Club membership year will be charged a pro-rata amount for the rest of the year until June and entered in the next available draw following payment.
9. A member is eligible for inclusion in the draw so long as the subscription for that quarter has been paid.
10. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the Club if his or her renewal of subscription remains unpaid for a period of one quarter.
11. Members wishing to leave the 100 Club should do so at the end of the current membership year. Refunds will not be given for people wishing to withdraw before the year end.
12. Registers will be kept recording the name and address of each member, the number(s) allocated to them and the subscriptions received from them.
13. The relevant numbers of all paid up members will be entered in the draw for each quarter..
14. The draw for each quarter will be made at Band rehearsals in the presence of at least five members of the Band and at least one Trustee of the Band. Draws scheduled to take place during holidays will be done whenever practical.
15. The regular quarterly prize fund will be of 50% of the quarterly income— there will be three prizes:-
 - 1st prize = 50% of quarterly prize fund (e.g. £187.50 if 100 members)
 - 2nd prize = 30% of quarterly prize fund (e.g. £112.50 if 100 members)
 - 3rd prize = 20% of quarterly prize fund (e.g. £75 if 100 members)The quarterly draws will take place in March, June, September and December
16. The 100 Club Treasurer will make all reasonable efforts to pay or post prizes to the winners within a reasonable period after the quarterly draw.
17. Prize winners will be notified by email or by SMS message and payment of winnings will be made by cheque to the address shown on the membership application form or to such other address as the member may subsequently have advised. Quarterly results will be published on the Band's website.
18. If a winner cannot be contacted winnings will be transferred to Longridge Band funds after 6 months.
19. The decision of the Longridge Band 100 Club Committee shall be final in all matters requiring adjudication.
20. The Longridge Band 100 Club Committee shall also have the power to amend or revoke these rules at their absolute discretion with such reasonable notice to the 100 Club members as is necessary.
